She wrote us this letter to mark the school's 30th anniversary: "My name is Stanzin Zompa. I was born in a small village called Raru in 1990. That time there was no school in my village except a rented room by Government with hardly any teacher. There was no road at all, only small paths for yak or horses. At that time we had to bring all things from Padum on horses, donkeys or yaks. At that time our life was very difficult and we suffered a lot from our meager living conditions. In



1993, a trekking group called the Shambhala Group came to Raru. They met with the people of Raru and decided to open a private school. All the villagers agreed to this idea. I was very sad because my family was very poor and could not pay the school fees. I remember not being able to eat for two days, I was so disappointed. Days later, a member of the school staff came to us for breakfast and told us that Shambhala Charitable Trust will also sponsor poor children.

I was very excited. Next year, more students joined and we studied a lot to get good marks at school. Gradually, our school became one of the best in the Zanskar Valley.

After a year, I got a small job from the government as a teacher. After five years, I was given a permanent job by the government.

During this



time, I married a young man from the village of Tangzay. His name is Stanzin Phunchok. We got married with the permission of both our families, who were both very poor.

So we arranged a small gathering with the closest family members, as we didn't have enough money to organize a big celebration.

And now I have four angels in my life, four wonderful daughters. We are very happy together.

youngest daughter Skarma was admitted to my former school Jamyang Ling, where I was the first student at the time. She lives with her grandparents in Raru and goes to school every day.

I would like to thank the people of Shambhala Charitable Trust very much for making it possible for me to attend school in Raru and later on three years in Jammu at Professor Kotwals Private School wher I completed class 12. Without the foundation of the Jamyang Ling school and without all the support, I would never have been able to get this education. At all I am very grateful for that.
